#### Responsibilities and Duties

- o Conduct interviews with clients; prepare the clients profiles
- o Make family and community assessments, evaluations, referrals, agreements and follow-up
- o Monthly counseling with each client in the program about their health, studying and other obstacles with their family, friends and life partner
- o Maintain confidential information of the clients and keep record with all the problems of the clients
- o Collect attendance list of clients from vocational training project every month
- o Prepare financial support for clients
- o Build good relationships with client’s parents and their local authority
- o Encourage the clients with information to help them have a good future
- o Assist the clients to create their own business plan and find a job after graduation
- o Encourage the clients to find mentors who have business backgrounds to support them
- o Communicate and update the client’s information to their family and authority every three months
- o Prepare case plans with each client for three months ahead of graduation
- o Work closely with PW clients and treat them with dignity and respect
- o Do other tasks required by supervisor or director
