Who We Are

Precious Women Organization (PWO) is a Cambodian Christian non-profit organization committed to empowering women and protecting vulnerable girls through holistic care, practical opportunities, and long-term relationships.

We believe every woman and every girl possesses inherent worth, dignity, and God-given potential.

Many of the women we meet have experienced poverty, broken families, exploitation, violence, or limited educational and employment opportunities. Rather than offering only short-term assistance, Precious Women walks alongside each individual as she rebuilds confidence, develops practical skills, strengthens family relationships, and creates a sustainable future.

Everything we do is grounded in one simple belief: **Lasting change happens through relationships.**



OUR VISION:

For Cambodian women who are working in the entertainment industry and at risk of exploitation to live in freedom, with hope and dignity.

OUR MISSION:

1. Promote better working conditions for women who work in the entertainment industries so they can avoid sexual and economic exploitation by empowering them opportunities to gain vocational skills, soft skills, and rehabilitation.
2. Prevent young women, who are vulnerable to exploitation, by giving them opportunities to get better education.

CORE VALUES:

1. We believe all women are created unique and equal by God
2. We believe all women have the same value in society
3. We believe all women deserve protection and support
4. We believe all women are precious

What Makes Precious Women Different?



Many organizations provide services. Some offer education. Some provide vocational training. Others respond to immediate needs. At Precious Women, we believe lasting transformation requires something more. It requires someone willing to walk alongside another person over time. Our work does not begin with a program. It begins with a relationship.

We meet women where they are, listen to their stories, understand their circumstances, and journey with them toward a future they may not yet believe is possible.

As trust grows, practical opportunities follow. Some women receive counselling and emotional support. Others participate in life-skills training, vocational training, or business development. Young girls receive educational support that helps them remain in school and pursue brighter futures. Families receive encouragement, guidance, and practical assistance as they work toward greater stability.

We walk alongside each woman until hope becomes confidence, confidence becomes opportunity, and opportunity becomes lasting independence.

How We Walk Alongside Women

Every woman's journey is unique, but the pathway toward lasting change often follows five connected steps.

Reach

We build trusted relationships through regular outreach, meeting women where they are and creating safe spaces where they are seen, heard, and valued.

Restore

Through counselling, mentoring, community, and spiritual encouragement, women begin rebuilding confidence, healing from difficult experiences, and discovering renewed hope.

Equip

Vocational training, life-skills education, and personal development prepare women with practical skills to pursue sustainable employment and independent livelihoods.

Empower

Business grants, employment opportunities, educational scholarships, and family support enable women and girls to create stable futures and strengthen their households.

Transform

As women gain confidence, stability, and purpose, they become leaders within their families and sources of encouragement for others, creating a ripple effect that extends far beyond one individual.

IMPACT AT A GLANCE

January – June 2026

Over the past six months, Precious Women has continued to walk alongside vulnerable women, girls, and families mainly in Phnom Penh, providing practical support, new opportunities, and pathways toward sustainable future.

I. Outreach & Protection

- 12 Night Outreach Visits
- 90 Women connected through outreach
 - 65 women working in entertainment industries
 - 25 Independent adult service providers
- 4 Coordination meetings with local authorities to strengthen community protection and support.

II. Healing & Well-being

- 36 Individual counselling and mentoring sessions
- 22 Women referred for medical care and health services
- 10 Women connected to a local church community for ongoing fellowship and support.

III. Skills & Sustainable Livelihoods

- 5 Women sponsored into vocational training
 - 1 Beauty Salon
 - 4 Speciality Coffee
- 15 Employment opportunities shared
- 4 Women secured new employment.
- 10 Women who received business start-up grants in 2025 have continued to receive regular coaching visits, business assessments, and practical guidance.

IV. Education

- 21 Girls received educational sponsorships from preschool through high school.
- 2 Young women continued their university education through college scholarships.
- 30 Children attended Precious Women's preschool program.

V. Partnerships

6 Local authorities actively engaged in strengthening community collaboration. Ongoing partnerships were maintained with:

- Local churches
- Community leaders
- Vocational trainers
- Entertainment venue owners
- Government representatives

Together, these partnerships help create safer environments and expand opportunities for vulnerable women and girls.

Lives Behind the Numbers

"Transformation is never just a statistic. It is found in the courage of women who choose hope over fear and opportunity over uncertainty."

Throughout this report, we have shared program, partnerships, and progress. Behind each of these are real women and girls whose lives have been shaped through relationships, practical opportunities, and faithful support.

The following stories represent only a few of the many women and families who have walked alongside Precious Women. Their journeys are different, but they share one common truth: lasting change is possible when someone believes in your future before you can see it yourself.

From Uncertainty to Opportunity

Channy's Story

"I never imagined that a small business could change the future of my family."

When Channy first met the Precious Women outreach team, she was working in Phnom Penh's entertainment industry. Like many women, she carried the daily responsibility of providing for her family while facing uncertainty about what tomorrow might bring.

Although she longed for a different future, she saw few opportunities to build one.

Everything began with a conversation.



During regular outreach visits, the Precious Women team built a relationship with Channy, listening to her story and encouraging her to participate in the Women Empowerment Program. Through life-skills training, mentoring, and group activities, she began rebuilding confidence and discovering strengths she had never recognized in herself.

Then COVID-19 changed everything.

As the entertainment industry closed, Channy lost her primary source of income. What had once been uncertain suddenly became a crisis.

Precious Women responded immediately by providing emergency food assistance and ongoing emotional support. Yet even in the middle of uncertainty, the team continued looking beyond the immediate need. Through family visits and individual coaching, they discovered Channy's desire to own a small food business.

Recognizing both her determination and potential, Precious Women partnered with generous supporters to provide the equipment she needed to begin selling grilled meat bread.

That opportunity changed everything.

Today, Channy operates her own small business, earning a stable income that enables her to provide daily meals for her family, support her children's education, and look toward the future with renewed confidence.

Looking back, Channy says the greatest gift was not simply the business itself. It was knowing that someone believed in her before she fully believed in herself.

Her journey reminds us that transformation often begins with one relationship, one opportunity, and one person willing to walk alongside another.

A Future Worth Protecting

Chenda's Story



"Education gave me hope. One day I want to become a nurse so I can care for families who cannot afford medical treatment."

At eighteen years old, Chenda is preparing for one of the most important moments of her life, Cambodia's Grade 12 national examination.

She dreams of becoming a nurse. Not simply to build a career, but to care for people living in poverty who struggle to access healthcare.

Her dream was shaped by her own family's journey.

Originally from Prey Veng Province, Chenda's family moved to Phnom Penh seeking better opportunities. Her father worked as a construction worker, earning less than ten dollars a day, while her mother remained unemployed. Living in rented accommodation, the family often struggled to meet their daily needs, and continuing school became increasingly uncertain.

Despite these challenges, Chenda remained a dedicated student and consistently ranked among the highest performers in her class.

In 2023, Precious Women began supporting her through the Prevention Program by providing a scholarship that allowed her to remain in school.

Precious Women, we recognized that supporting Chenda's family was a mean to be stable. Through regular family engagement, encouragement, and practical assistance, Precious Women helped Chenda's mother secure stable employment. Today, she earns approximately USD 250 each month, bringing greater stability to the household and allowing Chenda to focus on her studies.

Along this journey, the family also experienced hope in a different way. Through their relationship with Precious Women, they began attending church and discovered comfort and encouragement during one of the most challenging seasons of their lives.

Today, Chenda is preparing confidently for graduation and looks forward to continuing her education at university. She hopes that one day she will return the compassion she has received by serving others as a nurse.

Her story reminds us that education does more than keep a child in school. It protects dreams, strengthens families, and creates opportunities that can change the course of an entire generation.

More Than a New Skill

Kimlang's Story



"Someone believed in me when I couldn't see a future for myself. Today, I want to become that person for other women."

Every morning, Kimlang unlocks the doors of her beauty salon with gratitude.

As customers begin arriving, she welcomes each one with confidence. The salon is more than a business and it is a symbol of how much her life has changed. Every haircut, every manicure, and every satisfied customer reminds her that the future she once thought was impossible has become her reality.

Today, Kimlang earns between **USD 400 and USD 700 each month**, providing financial security for herself and contributing to her family's well-being.

But only a few years ago, her life looked very different.

Growing up in Battambang Province, Kimlang experienced financial hardship from an early age. After her parents divorced, her mother carried the responsibility of raising four children alone. Unable to afford school fees, Kimlang left school after Grade 7 to help support her family.

She accepted whatever work she could find.

Eventually, like many young women facing poverty and limited opportunities, she entered Phnom Penh's entertainment industry.

It was during one of Precious Women's regular outreach visits that someone stopped to listen to her story.

The team saw more than her circumstances. They saw resilience. They saw determination.

Most importantly, they saw potential.

As trust grew, Kimlang shared a dream she had never stopped carrying.

She wanted to learn a professional skill that would allow her to leave the entertainment industry and build a different future.

Precious Women responded by enrolling her in professional beauty salon training.

For eight months, Kimlang learned hair design, nail care, and make-up artistry while receiving practical encouragement from instructors, mentoring from Precious Women staff, and unwavering support from her family.

To remove one more barrier, Precious Women also provided her with a bicycle so she could travel to training every day.

Completing the course was a significant achievement, but Precious Women understood that training alone would not change her future.

She needed an opportunity.

In 2025, Precious Women provided business start-up support that enabled Kimlang to establish her own beauty salon.

That investment became the turning point in her life.

Today, her salon is growing steadily and provides a stable monthly income that allows her to plan for the future with confidence and dignity.

Yet what inspires us most is not the success of her business. It is the dream she now carries for others. Kimlang has never forgotten where her journey began.

She hopes that one day her salon will become a place where women in crisis, especially those seeking to leave the entertainment industry can learn beauty salon skills **free of charge**.

She wants to become the person who once believed in her.

Her dream reflects the heart of Precious Women.

Transformation is complete when the person who once needed hope becomes someone who offers hope to others. Kimlang's story reminds us that changing one life can create opportunities for many more.

Measuring Our Impact

Every Number Represents a Life

Behind every statistic is a woman rebuilding confidence, a girl pursuing her education, or a family discovering new possibilities.

Monitoring and evaluation help Precious Women remain accountable, strengthen programs, and ensure that every activity contributes to meaningful and lasting change.

Throughout the first half of 2026, our team monitored program activities through participant registration, family assessments, counselling records, follow-up visits, mentoring, attendance records, and regular program reviews.

These systems help us understand what is working well, identify opportunities for improvement, and continue providing high-quality support to every woman and girl we serve.

Mid-Year Highlights

- Women continued to build trusted relationships through regular outreach.
- Women participated in empowerment training, counselling, and vocational development.
- Women established new livelihoods through employment and small business opportunities.
- Girls remained in school through scholarships and strengthened family support.
- Staff completed **32 professional development participation**, strengthening organizational capacity and program quality.

Financial Stewardship

Faithfully Managing Every Gift

Every contribution entrusted to Precious Women represents more than financial support. It represents a shared belief that women and girls deserve the opportunity to build lives marked by dignity, hope, and independence.

During the first six months of 2026, Precious Women received **USD 129,995.38** in funding and **USD 83,593.34** was spent in program implementation and organizational operations. At the end of the reporting period, **USD 46,402.04** remained available to support program activities and organizational priorities during the second half of 2026.

Of all the finance spent during this period:

USD 69,732.31 was used directly in program activities, including Women's Outreach, Women's Empowerment, Butterfly, and Prevention Program.

USD 13,861.03 supported General & Administration, ensuring that program were delivered effectively, responsibly, and sustainably.

We remain committed to stewarding every resource with integrity, accountability, and transparency. Financial records are managed in accordance with organizational policies.

Because every dollar invested represents an opportunity to restore hope, create opportunity, and transform lives.

Looking Ahead

The Journey Continues

The first half of 2026 has been a season of growth, learning, and transformation.

Together with our partners, we have walked alongside women rebuilding their lives, celebrated young girls continuing their education, strengthened families through practical support, and witnessed women discover the confidence to pursue new opportunities.

These achievements encourage us, but they also remind us why our mission remains so important.

Across Cambodia, many women continue working in the entertainment industry because they see few alternatives. Many girls remain vulnerable to leaving school due to financial hardship, and many families continue searching for opportunities that will enable them to build stable and dignified lives.

These realities strengthen our commitment for the months ahead.

During the second half of 2026, Precious Women will continue to focus on five priorities.

Building Relationships

Continuing regular outreach to women working in the entertainment industry, creating safe spaces where they are seen, heard, and valued.

Creating Opportunities

Expanding vocational training, employment pathways, and entrepreneurship opportunities so that more women can achieve financial independence.

Protecting Girls

Supporting vulnerable girls to remain in school while strengthening families so education becomes a pathway toward a brighter future.

Strengthening the Organization

Continuing to invest in staff development, organizational systems, and program quality to ensure every woman receives compassionate and professional support.

Growing Partnerships

Working together with churches, businesses, foundations, government partners, and generous supporters who share our vision of restoring hope and creating opportunity

Our vision has not changed.

We remain committed to walking alongside women and girls until hope becomes confidence, confidence becomes opportunity, and opportunity becomes lasting independence.

The work continues.

And together, so does the hope.
